**5th commandment: *You shall not murder.***

*(What does this mean?)*

We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and be a friend to him in every bodily need.

Isaiah 55:6 Seek the LORD *while* he may be found.

Man is destined to die *once*, and after that to face judgment.

Psalms 31:15 My times are in *Your* hands.

Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult.

1 John 3:15 Anyone who *hates* his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life in him.

*Extra Credit: Ephesians 4:31, 32 Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.*

## KEY TERMS

**Time of Grace:** The lifetime that God gives a person to repent and come to faith in Jesus

**Suicide:** Self-murder. (Tragic!: Taking one's own life doesn't leave time to repent and usually dooms the soul to hell)

**Abortion:** To take the life of a child before it is born.

**Mercy Death:** To cause someone to die and then call it "love" or "mercy".

**Capital Punishment:** God commands government to execute people for certain crimes.

**Sanctity of human life:** man's life is special, holy, an image of God--So only God or his representative may take life!

1. Evaluate this statement: Nature is a textbook that tells us about God.

2. Jillian's teacher asked the students in her class to think of what they were most thankful for. Jillian's answer was the Bible. Why do you think she said that?

3. When Jason invited Mr. Daley to church, Mr. Daley answered, "I don't put much stock in the Bible. It's just the words and ideas of men." If you were Jason, how would you respond?

4. The Bible tells us that our sins are forgiven and that all who believe that Jesus is our Savior have eternal life. How can we be absolutely certain that is true?
