KEY TERMS (Be ready to put each definition in your own words)

Flawless = the Bible has no mistakes (from *Psalms* 18:30)

Inerrant = the Bible has no errors (same as "flawless")

1400 B.C. -- 100 A.D. = the years during which the Bible was written

Law = One of the 2 main Bible teachings, the law commands what we are to do or not to do

Gospel = The other main Bible teaching, the gospel is the good news of our Savior!

Doctrine = teaching

Civil Law = Laws telling how to punish crimes in Israel before Christ came.

Ceremonial Law = Laws which showed people before Christ how to worship.

Moral Law = Laws which tell what God wants all people of all time to do.

Sin of Omission = Not doing something which God wants us to do.

Sin of Commission = Doing something which God forbids.
